Jerry S. Staley, 75, of Dix, passed away Sunday, January 27, 2019, at his home. He was born September 1, 1943, the son of Elmer and Evelyn Staley. On June 7, 1967, he married Mary M. Karch, and she survives.

Jerry began his education in a one room school, and graduated from Field Grade School before graduating from Mt. Vernon Township High School. He continued his education, graduating from Southern Illinois University Carbondale with a B.S. in Engineering.
