Dorothy Tinsley, 91, of Dix, passed away at 7:20 a.m. Wednesday, March 22, 2017, at Mt. Vernon Countryside Manor.

She was born October 2, 1925, in Doniphan, Missouri, the daughter of Harrison and Della (Jarrett) Justice. On November 16, 1946, in Dix, she married Charles Frank Tinsley, and he preceded her in death on April 2, 2010. She was a member of Boyd Christian Church. She loved her family and enjoyed her grandchildren. During World War II, she worked in a munitions factory.
