Martin Hampton, 96, of Opdyke, Illinois, passed away peacefully Wednesday, April 26, 2023, at White Oak Rehabilitation and Health Care Center in Mt. Vernon, Illinois.

He was born March 27, 1927, in Belle Rive, Illinois, to the late Harry "Gene" and Helen (Butts) Hampton. Martin married Mary A. Modlin in Mt. Vernon, and they were blessed with 58 years of marriage before she preceded him in death in 2012.
