Mary Kay Sumner, 75, of Mt. Vernon, passed away at 2:10 a.m., Sunday, August 20, 2023, at Mt. Vernon Countryside Manor.

Mary was born on September 9, 1947 in Mt. Vernon, IL, the youngest of 10 children born to Joe Vincent and Minnie Madeline (Whitsell) Rector. She and many of her siblings were delivered by the neighbor and Minnie would deliver the neighbor's babies. She attended Little Grove Grade School, a 1 room schoolhouse, and graduated from Woodlawn Grade School and Woodlawn High School. She married Larry Sumner on December 7, 1968. She worked at Happy Time Day Care where she cared for and rocked hundreds of babies over the course of 19 years. She was a kind, loving Christian woman and a member of New Hope "Webb" Missionary Baptist Church. Mary loved to travel and rode all over the country on a Gold Wing motorcycle with her husband.

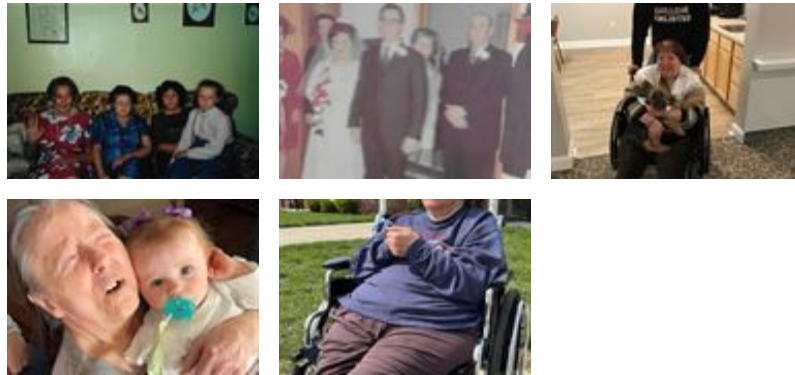
