



## Michael Douglas McDaniel

Michael Douglas McDaniel, 67, of Dix, passed away 7:22 p.m. Saturday, August 17, 2019, at his home, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born November 10, 1951, in Centralia, the son of Otho D. McDaniel and Mary L. (Sisson) Robbins. On September 1, 2018, at City Hope Church in Centralia, he married Myrt Porter, and she survives in Dix.

He worked as a Millwright at Rockwell for 19 years, and then worked in shipping and receiving at Southwire for ten years. After retirement, he was employed by the Jefferson County Sherriff's Office, doing maintenance and janitorial work. He attended Centralia High School and two years at Kaskaskia College.

He served in the United States Army, in Vietnam, as a Gunner and Mechanic, obtaining the rank of Sergeant. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, a Good Conduct Medal, and the merit of Wings. He was a collector of vintage toys and money, loved riding his tractor, and loved spending time in his garage with friends and family.
