



Thomas Wayne Mosbarger

Thomas Wayne Mosbarger, 84, of Centralia, passed away Friday, November 6, 2020, at Hamilton Memorial Hospital in McCleansboro, IL.

He was born October 26, 1936, in Grayville, IL, the son of Woodrow T. Mosbarger and Eleanor Ann McCurdy.
